Primary Engineer LEADERS AWARD

In February this year, Rhine Class entered a competition – “If you were an engineer, what would you do?” As part of the process they interviewed an engineer, Mr Kevin Cannon from DE&S. They then had to identify a need which they could address and design a solution for. They drew and annotated their design and wrote a 100-word pitch letter to explain why their design should be chosen.

All sorts of wonderful ideas ensued, from automatic pet feeders to a “Carry more” rucksack with arms, from a Goalie-tron penalty practice machine to a clever wheelchair.

We were really pleased to find out that two of our pupils have done particularly well, Anna was shortlisted for Year 6 and Lizzie achieved Highly Commended for Year 5. This achievement puts them in the top 1% of 2700+ entrants in the South West.

There is an exhibition of finalists' work at the University of the West of England on Saturday 30th June 2018. Anyone is welcome to attend, it is a public event and Anna's and Lizzie's work will be on display. Our school provides a milk scheme that is available to all of our pupils and we would like to invite you to register your child. Milk is available at a subsidised price of 22pence per day.

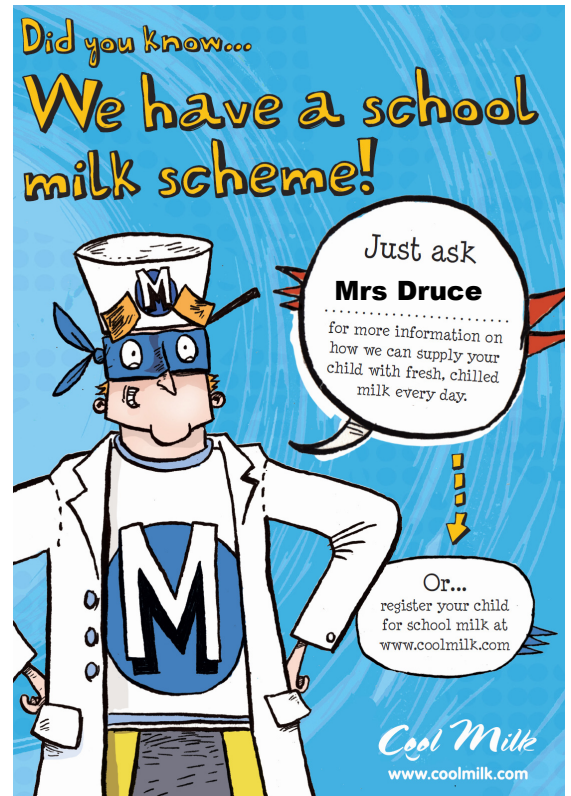
