Malmesbury School invites you to a Presentation  
on

**'A Pollutant's Tale' – A Lecture-Demonstration  
by Tim Harrison**

**Monday 1 October 2018 at 6.30 pm**

Tim Harrison is the first School Teacher Fellow at Bristol ChemLabS and the Science Communicator in Residence and Director of Outreach. Tim's work is mainly in the promotion of chemistry and he has won many awards including the Royal Society of Chemistry School's Education Award and an inaugural Hawksbee Award from the Royal Society.

### The lecture covers

- the composition of the Earth's atmosphere in comparison to other planets
- a brief description of the structure of the atmosphere
- investigation of some of the chemistry and properties of nitrogen and oxygen
- a few of the tropospheric pollutants including carbon dioxide

Throughout the lecture there are demonstrations including some involving liquid nitrogen, oxygen foam, dry ice and a few explosions. The lecture will also include climate change.
