LO: To know about the life of a significant individual.  
To take on the role of Darwin the naturalist.

Today you are going to take on the role as a naturalist.

Explain that Sir David Attenborough is a current day naturalist and he visited the Galapagos and followed in Darwin's footsteps, this time with cameras and a television crew so that we too can see what Darwin saw.
