Our School Uniform Policy

- Black or grey trousers/skirt/pinafore dress
- White shirt/blouse/polo shirt
- School sweatshirt in royal blue or school sweat cardigan/knitted cardigan in royal blue
- Royal blue fleece for outdoor wear (Optional)
- Plain dark or neutral socks/tights (please send in a spare pair of socks if your child wears tights)
- Navy, black or brown sensible shoes to be worn at all times. The wearing of trainers or fashion shoes is not allowed for health and safety reasons. Boots should not be worn inside, so please send indoor shoes for your child to change into.

Also, we ask that children with hair that is longer than shoulder length that it is tied back. This is more so for health and safety reasons, but trying to get glue and/or paint out of hair can be somewhat difficult and painful! Also that children are not permitted to wear make up in school this includes nail varnish. Please keep these for special occasions at home.

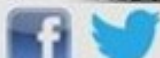
