Red	A child can use a comfortable and efficient pencil
	grip, form a controlled line and make marks.
Orange	A child can now write <u>some</u> letters using a pre-
	cursive style and the correct sequence of movements.
Green	A child can now write <u>all</u> lower case letters using a
	pre-cursive style and the correct sequence of
	movements.
Blue	A child can now write both lower and upper case
	letters using a pre-cursive style and the correct
	sequence of movements.
Purple	A child can now use the correct handwriting joins
	in independent writing.
Gold Pen	A child now makes a real effort to continuously
	produce carefully joined handwriting of a high
Licence	standard.
Platinum.	A child has shared their skills and supported others
	with improving their handwriting too.
