Anti - Bullying Policy

Bullying is when you are picked on by the same person over and over again. They might hurt you or say nasty things.

If you are being bullied you should:

- **TELL** the bully to stop and walk away
- **TELL** a grown up in school
- **TELL** a grown up at home.

This is what we think should happen to anyone who is a bully.

1. An older child (from Rhine Class) may speak to them to remind them about how to treat people.
2. The teacher on duty speaks to them
3. A teacher gives them some time out, as a way to give them time to think about what they have done.
4. Mrs Winterburn speaks to them.
5. Their parents are asked to come to school to discuss the problem with Mrs. Winterburn.
