### How to get info about what's happening at Stanton school

We have so many wonderful things happening at school and we do our best to let our families know about them. It's often very interesting for parents and children to find out what other year groups are doing in the school so there are a few ways we do this:

**Weekly Newsletter** - emailed out to all families on a Thursday, and you can also find copies of this on our website if you lose it in your inbox.

**School News app** - brings any news items or blog posts onto your phone or tablet - just search in the App Store for it.

**Facebook page** - please 'like' our school page as we are trying to regularly update it with school news, activities and FOSS events

FOSS info - this is always in the school newsletter, and also on the SSQ Facebook page.

#### School News App—how the app works

Firstly, you will need to download the app from either the <u>iTunes App Store</u>, <u>Google Play</u> or <u>Windows Store</u> by clicking on the relevant buttons below or by loading up the app store on your phone and searching for '**School News**'.



Once you have located and downloaded the free app, launch the app and you will then be able to either click on the 'Find my school' button which uses the phones GPS to locate all the schools in the surrounding 20 miles, or you can type in the schools postcode and click on 'Get my school' button. Your school's postcode is: SN14 6DQ

You will then see a list of schools that use the app. Click on the school you wish to view news & events for.

You will then be able to click on the 'News' button to view all of the latest news items that have been added to the school(s) you have selected and also all of the upcoming calendar events by clicking on the 'Events' button.

Clicking on 'My Schools' will display a list of schools that you view news and events for. Clicking on one of the schools will the display the school address, telephone number and email address which you can click on to either phone or email the school directly from the app.
