

# Squashy Box - verbs/adjectives/nouns

## How to use:

Cut out the squashy box folding each column and gluing together at the two edges. This will give you a 3D cuboid shape.

## Here are some suggestions of how it can be used:

- identifying verbs, adjectives and nouns
- count how many verbs/adjectives/nouns there are
- think of alternative verbs or adjectives
- count how many syllables are in each word
- one child chooses a secret word and others must ask questions to work out the secret word (e.g. Is it an adjective? Is it a verb? Does it have more than two syllables?)
- reinforce ordering language (e.g. What is the third word? What is the fifth word?)
- Go to column A - are there more adjectives than nouns?
