Leaf Painting / Rubbing - Choose some different leaves and explore their shape and texture. What can you see? Do you know the name of the tree the leaves have come from?

Paint the underside of the leaves and then press down onto white paper. If you don't have paints, put the leaf underneath the paper (underside upwards) and rub\_with crayon.

What do you notice? KUW, CLL.



Message on a Banana Experiment— Use a cocktail stick to write a message or draw a picture on the skin of a banana. Press firmly enough to dent the skin, but not too hard to break the skin. Wait for the message / picture to appear!!!! CLL, KUW, Maths

Mini Bug Hotel— using part of a plastic bottle or milk bottle and objects from the garden, create a mini bug hotel. Check regularly to see what bugs have made it their home. Can you draw and label them? KUW, CLL, Writing, Physical development.

Cloud Gazing – Spend some time gazing up at the clouds. Discussing what you can see encourages verbal literacy, descriptive skills and creating ideas. Can you make up stories to link the different things you can see in the clouds.
