





*n.* a flood or overflowing water like gushing water from a blocked toilet







# diverse

like a group of people who are all different from each other







## engrossed

like when something has your full attention






## minuscule

### adj. tiny or microscopic


like an insect so small you can barely see it

### *adj.* sad, longing, or nostalgic like the sad feeling you get from some memories







# innovative

like the genius who carved the first wheel out of stone






### havoc

like the mess caused by a giant bear smashing through a city







## cluttered

like a room with clothes and toys thrown all over the place






# delirious
