Session 3 – Baptism

There are lots of video clips to watch today. Make sure you have time to talk about each one when it is finished and then compare what you learn at the end.

When Christians are baptised (or Christened), either as a baby or at any other time in their lives, they are baptised in the name of the Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit.

If you or your child were baptised you might like to get out the photos, candle and baptism certificate to talk about what happened on the day.

Babies are usually baptised in a font at church. Water is poured over their heads and the sign of the cross is made on their foreheads.

Adults are often baptised by going completely under the water, either in a big pool in church or outside in a river or pool.
