Can you guess where you might find these fantastic windows?






IMPORTANT—End of Term Information

- We will post on the school Facebook page. We will inform BBC Radio Wiltshire and


- Heart Radio.

If YES you need to inform the school as soon as possible The school will need the following information to carry out a risk assessment of who may be a close contact:

Date of onset of COVID-19 symptoms (including what symptoms they had)

Date of the test

How do they get to school? E.g. walk, cycle, car, public transport, school transport, taxi

Date your child was last in school

(and evidence of the result/ID number)

Please provide any additional information you may have as to pupils or staff your child may have been in contact with during this period.

Please note: The infectious period is 48 hours prior to the onset of symptoms (or date of the test if tested when asymptomatic).
