Dressing up!

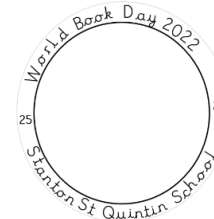
Come to school dressed as your favourite book character! We welcome you to also bring the book from which you have chosen your character. Please ensure all books are named.
